



Before Treatment

Why do I need Iron..

Iron plays a key role in many processes, especially facilitating the formation of red blood cells and enabling them to carry oxygen around the body.

A lack of iron can make you feel tired, short of breath and it can also cause poor concentration and a general lack of energy.

The Iron Clinic specialises in the provision of intravenous iron infusions. An iron infusion is a rapid way to correct iron deficiency and anaemia.

Preparation prior to receiving iron..

The doctor will want to talk to you before you start treatment to make sure that you are suitable. There is no special preparation required, you can eat and drink as you normally do and take your usual medication.

An intravenous iron infusion can rapidly replace all your iron stores in one treatment.

During Treatment

How is the iron administered..

The iron is given intravenously which means directly into a vein. The infusion will run into your vein from a drip and you will be monitored by a nurse throughout the procedure.

Are there any side effects during treatment..

As with all medicines there can be side effects, although not everyone gets them.

Common side effects include headache, dizziness and mild nausea. Severe side effects are very rare.

How long will the procedure take..

The time taken for an infusion depends on the iron dose needed, this can be just over 15 minutes up to 30 minutes.

You will be observed for 30 minutes by the nurse following the infusion before being able to leave and carry on your day as normal.

After Treatment

When will I feel the effect..

The time it takes for each patient to feel improvement in their symptoms is very individual. Lots of people have reported feeling better after only a couple of days, while others will feel improvement after a few weeks.

What happens after treatment..

The Iron Clinic will send a letter to your GP informing them of the treatment you have received and our contact details in case there are any questions. We will request that you have a new blood sample taken 8 weeks after treatment to determine if your bodies iron stores are fully corrected.

We will discuss these results with you and advise on further treatment or management of your iron deficiency.
